## **Bill Summary**

The enhance school safety incident response grant program was created in 2018. The bill changes dates in the program regarding the application deadline and grant distribution deadline. The bill appropriates \$1,150,000 to the department of public safety from the school safety resource center cash fund for the grant program.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-2204,
3	amend (1) introductory portion and (3) as follows:
4	24-33.5-2204. Enhance school safety incident response grant
5	program - application - criteria - awards. (1) To receive a grant, an
6	applicant must submit an application to the division in the form
7	prescribed by the division on or before October 1 SEPTEMBER 1 each year
8	of the grant program. At a minimum, the application must include
9	documentation demonstrating that the applicant:
10	(3) Subject to available appropriations, on or before <del>December 1</del>
11	NOVEMBER 1 each year of the grant program, the division shall award
12	grants as provided in this part 22. The division shall distribute the grant
13	money within thirty days after awarding the grants.
14	<b>SECTION 2.</b> Appropriation. For the 2019-20 state fiscal year,
15	\$1,150,000 is appropriated to the department of public safety for use by
16	the office of preparedness. This appropriation is from the school safety
17	resource center cash fund created in section <u>24-33.5-1807 (1)</u> , C.R.S. To
18	implement this act, the office may use this appropriation for program
19	administration.
20	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
21	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
22	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
