A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 **CONCERNING ELIMINATING THE KIDNEY DISEASE PREVENTION AND**
102 **EDUCATION TASK FORCE, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH,**
103 **REDUCING AN APPROPRIATION.**

Bill Summary

1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** 25-1-136.

3 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal**
4 (17)(a)(VI) as follows:

5 **2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative**
6 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (17) (a) The following statutory
7 authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on
8 September 1, 2026:

9 (VI) ~~The kidney disease prevention and education task force~~
10 ~~created in section 25-1-136;~~

11 **SECTION 3. Appropriation - adjustments to 2025 long bill.** To
12 implement this act, the general fund appropriation made in the annual
13 general appropriation act for the 2025-26 state fiscal year to the
14 department of public health and environment for use by the prevention
15 services division for chronic disease and cancer prevention grants is
16 decreased by \$86,567, and the related FTE is decreased by 0.5 FTE.

17 **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly finds,
18 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
19 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
20 the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
21 institutions.
