WHEREAS, Colorado Governor Oliver Shoup approved a bill,	
introduced by Colorado State Representative William "Billy" H. Adams,	
establishing Adams State Normal School on May 4, 1921; and	
WHEREAS, The newly created college and the western railroad	
town of Alamosa experienced a symbiotic relationship, and the	
connection continued to develop throughout the last 100 years; and	
WHEREAS, The institution now known as Adams State	
University has educated thousands of Alamosa community leaders,	
bankers, accountants, business owners, doctors, attorneys, farmers and	

1	ranchers, and, most importantly, teachers during its 100 years; and
2 3 4	WHEREAS, For the last 100 years, Adams State University has been a key economic and educational institution for the City of Alamosa and the entire San Luis Valley; and
5 6 7	WHEREAS, Adams State University has more than 3,000 students enrolled and is vital to the ongoing health and well-being of Alamosa as a city and county and of the state of Colorado; and
8 9	WHEREAS, Adams State University was the first federally designated Hispanic Serving Institution in the state of Colorado; and
10 11 12	WHEREAS, Adams State University offers 27 Bachelor's degree programs, 9 Master's degree programs, and one Ph.D. degree program; and
13 14 15	WHEREAS, The Adams State University cross country and track and field programs have garnered an international reputation and brought Olympians to the City of Alamosa to train; now, therefore,
16 17	Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-third General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the Senate concurring herein:
18 19	That we, the members of the General Assembly, do hereby recognize 2021 as the "Year of Adams State".
