A BILL FOR AN ACT
CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE REGULATION OF PEOPLE
WHO MODIFY THE WEATHER, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH
IMPLEMENTING THE SUNSET REVIEW RECOMMENDATIONS OF
THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AGENCIES.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Sunset Process - House Health, Insurance, and Environment Committee. Sections 1 and 2 of the bill continue the regulation of people who modify the weather until 2033. Section 3 repeals a provision that Reading Unamended March 21, 2018

prohibits weather modification that benefits another state if the other state prohibits weather modification that benefits Colorado.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, repeal
3	(15)(a)(IV); and add (34) as follows:
4	24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies
5	and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment - legislative
6	declaration - repeal. (15) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both,
7	will repeal on September 1, 2018:
8	(IV) The issuance of permits for specific weather modification
9	operations through the executive director of the department of natural
10	resources in accordance with article 20 of title 36, C.R.S.;
11	(34) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, are
12	SCHEDULED FOR REPEAL ON SEPTEMBER 1, 2033:
13	(I) THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR SPECIFIC WEATHER
14	MODIFICATION OPERATIONS THROUGH THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE
15	DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 20

17	(b) This subsection (34) is repealed, effective September 1,

19	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 36-20-127 as
20	follows:
21	36-20-127. Repeal of article. This article ARTICLE 20 is repealed,
22	effective September 1, 2018. Prior to such 2033. Before its repeal, the
23	function of the issuance of permits for specific weather modifications
24	operations through the director shall be reviewed as provided for in THIS
25	ARTICLE 20 IS SCHEDULED FOR REVIEW IN ACCORDANCE WITH section

2	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, repeal 36-20-118 as
3	follows:
4	36-20-118. Operations affecting weather in other states.
5	Weather control operations may not be carried on in Colorado for the
6	purpose of affecting weather in any other state if that state prohibits such
7	operations to be carried on in that state for the benefit of Colorado or its
8	inhabitants.
9	SECTION 4. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
10	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
11	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
12	8, 2018, if adjournment sine die is on May 9, 2018); except that, if a
13	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
14	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
15	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
16	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
17	November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
18	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
