Bill Topic: MONEY IN CREATIVE INDUSTRIES CASH FUND

Summary of Fiscal Impact. The bill is codifies current practice for the Art in Public Places Program in statute. It has no fiscal impact on state or local governments.

Summary of Legislation

Under current law, a fraction of state funds used for capital construction projects goes to the Creative Industries Cash Fund for the Art in Public Places Program. The bill clarifies that unexpended money in the fund for this purpose is available to be spent in the next two fiscal years, consistent with the spending authority for capital projects.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill codifies current practice in statute. This does not change state or local government revenue or expenditures; as a result, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed by the Governor into law on May 20, 2022, and it took effect on August 9, 2022.
