After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:

HB25-1304 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to of the Whole with favorable the Committee recommendation:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 3, strike "(1) introductory portion and
- 2 (1)(b)" and substitute "(1) introductory portion, (1)(b), and (2)(a)".
- 3 Page 2, strike lines 12 through 25.
- 4 Page 3, strike lines 1 and 2, and substitute:
 - "(b) An order that the defendant is obligated to pay restitution, but that the specific amount of restitution shall be IS determined within the ninety-one SIXTY-THREE days FOLLOWING THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY'S SUBMISSION OF RESTITUTION INFORMATION PRESENTED TO THE COURT AS REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (2)(a) OF THIS SECTION, OR WITHIN THE SIXTY-THREE DAYS immediately following the order of conviction, WHICHEVER IS LATER, unless good cause is shown for extending the time period by which the restitution amount shall be IS determined;
 - The court shall base its order for restitution upon (2) (a) information presented to the court by the prosecuting attorney, who shall compile such information through victim impact statements or other means to determine the amount of restitution and the identities of the victims. Further, the prosecuting attorney shall present this information to the court prior to the order of conviction or within ninety-one SIXTY-THREE days, if it is not available prior to the order of conviction.
- 20 The court may extend this date if it finds that there are extenuating
- 21 circumstances affecting the prosecuting attorney's ability to determine
- 22 restitution.".
