A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE CONTINUATION OF THE EARLY CHILDHOOD LEADERSHIP COMMISSION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Sunset Process - Senate Education Committee. The bill continues the early childhood leadership commission housed in the department of early childhood for 5 years, repealing on September 1, 2030. Before its repeal, the commission is subject to a sunset review.

2	SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal
3	(16)(a)(VII); and add (21)(a)(II) as follows:
4	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative
5	declaration - definition - repeal. (16) (a) The following statutory
6	authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on
7	September 1, 2025:
8	(VII) The early childhood leadership commission created in
9	section 26.5-1-302.
10	(21) (a) The following statutory authorizations for designated
11	advisory committees will repeal on September 1, 2030:
12	(II) THE EARLY CHILDHOOD LEADERSHIP COMMISSION CREATED IN
13	SECTION 26.5-1-302.
14	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, amend 26.5-1-304
15	as follows:
16	26.5-1-304. Repeal of part. This part 3 is repealed, effective
17	September 1, 2025 SEPTEMBER 1, 2030. Before its repeal, the commission
18	is subject to review in accordance with section 2-3-1203.
19	SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
20	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
21	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except
22	that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V
23	of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this
24	act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take
25	effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
26	November 2026 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
27	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
