Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$3,000,000 General Fund to the Rural Jump-Start Zone Grant Fund and a corresponding appropriation from the cash fund to the Office of Economic Development and International Trade in the Office of the Governor.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001 Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to change the existing clause to address a technical error to reflect 0.5 FTE that are assumed in the appropriation, which is consistent with the Revised Fiscal Note.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2021-22 budget package \$3,000,000 General Fund to be appropriated for implementation of this bill. Specifically, the JBC package includes a place holder of \$800.0 million General Fund for those bills that are part of the "State Stimulus Package", and this bill is part of that package.
