**BILL TOPIC:** SERVICES IN CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES

#### **Summary of Legislation**

***Recommended by the Legislative Audit Committee***, this bill removes the requirement that the Division of Correctional Industries (commonly referred to as CCI) establish programs for vehicle maintenance, physical plant and facility maintenance, and food and laundry services for each of the state's correctional facilities.

#### **Background**

The services listed in this bill are currently provided through subprograms using inmate labor. According to a 2015 audit, the laundry and food services program employs about 2,550 inmates and the facilities maintenance program employs about 640 inmates.

#### **Assessment**

This bill corrects statute to align with current practice and is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 13, 2017, and takes effect August 9, 2017, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
