## **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that provides \$3.0 million General Fund in FY 2020-21 to the Department of Human Services, which amount is based on the assumption that the Department will receive \$3.0 million federal funds to implement the act. Any unspent funds as of July 1, 2021

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are made available through FY 2021-22 for the same purpose.

## **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2021-22 budget package \$3,000,000 General Fund to be appropriated for implementation of this bill. Specifically, the JBC package includes a place holder of \$800.0 million General Fund for those bills that are part of the "State Stimulus Package", and this bill is part of that package.
