Summary of No fiscal impact. This bill removes an obsolete requirement that the Board of **Fiscal Impact:** 

Health approve operating agreements that municipalities enter into for sewer construction work, and clarifies which entity adopts rules that govern sewer or waste

disposal into bodies of water. The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

## **Summary of Legislation**

This bill removes a requirement that the Board of Health in the Department of Public Health and Environment approve a joint operating agreement between a municipality and an industrial enterprise for construction work on sewer facilities. The bill clarifies that the Water Quality Control Commission, not the Board of Health, is the entity that establishes rules that a water conservancy district must comply with when using a body of water as a sewer outlet or for waste disposal.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

The Board of Health does not approve agreements that municipalities enter into for sewer construction work, or adopt rules governing waste disposal into bodies of water. The bill will not impact the workload, revenue, or expenditures of any state or local government agency, and is therefore assessed as having no fiscal impact.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 7, 2019, and takes effect on August 2, 2019, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
