Bill Summary

Sunset Process - House Education Committee. The Colorado special education fiscal advisory committee (committee) is scheduled to repeal July 1, 2016. The bill continues the committee indefinitely.

7	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal (3)
8	(cc) (I) as follows:
9	2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees. (3) The
10	following dates are the dates on which the statutory authorization for the
11	designated advisory committee is scheduled for repeal:
12	(cc) July 1, 2016:
13	(I) The Colorado special education fiscal advisory committee
14	created in section 22-20-114.5 (2), C.R.S.;
15	SECTION 3. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
16	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
17	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
