Committee on Appropriations.
After consideration on the merits, the Committee recommends the following:
HB22-1376 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation:
Amend printed bill, page 14, line 9, strike "TWO MILLION" twice and substitute "FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND".
Page 17, after line 16, insert:
"SECTION 10. Appropriation. (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$1,016,451 is appropriated to the department of education. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows:  (a) \$263,900 for information technology services;  (b) \$500,000 for the expelled and at-risk student services grant program; and  (c) \$252,551 for the office of dropout prevention and student reengagement, which amount is based on an assumption that the department will require an additional 2.4 FTE.  (2) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$30,000 is appropriated to the department of law for use by the peace officers training board. This appropriation is from the P.O.S.T board cash fund created in section 24-31-303 (2)(b), C.R.S. To implement this act, the board may use this
appropriation for peace officers standards and training board support.".
Renumber succeeding section accordingly.
