Fiscal Impact of Bill as Amended to Date

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

- **J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$9,973,585 General Fund to the Department of Labor and Employment for FY 2018-19. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on an assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.8 FTE.
- **J.003** Bill Sponsor amendment **J.003** (attached) appropriates \$1,000,000 General Fund to the Department of Labor and Employment for FY 2018-19. This provision also states that the

appropriation is based on an assumption that the Department of Labor and Employment will require an additional 0.8 FTE. This provision also amends the bill to allow up to 10.0 percent (rather than 3.0 percent in the introduced bill) to be spent for the Department's direct costs of administration.

The Committee may adopt J.001 or it may adopt J.003, but it should *not* adopt both amendments.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2018-19 based on the March 2018 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The proposed budget package for FY 2018-19, as amended by General Assembly action on the Long Bill, includes a \$16,821,118 General Fund set-aside for increased funding for FY 2018-19 for higher education. This bill provides an appropriation to the Department of Labor and Employment for grants to higher education governing boards and K-12 local education providers.
