WHEREAS, The Pioneers are members of the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) Division I; and

WHEREAS, The Pioneers are now tied with Michigan for the most NCAA National Men's Ice Hockey Championships at 9 titles; and

WHEREAS, The Pioneers have won 15 regular season conference championships and 14 conference playoff championships; and

WHEREAS, 75 Pioneers have gone on to play in the National Hockey League (NHL); and

WHEREAS, Two Pioneers have been recognized as the best player in collegiate hockey with the prestigious Hobey Baker Award, which is an annual award given to the top NCAA men's ice hockey player; and

WHEREAS, On Saturday, April 9, 2022, the Pioneers added their ninth national title to their already stellar record, triumphing over Minnesota State by a score of 5-1; and

WHEREAS, The Pioneers have demonstrated their winning values both on and off the ice, as they participate in community-building efforts and always aspire to a "service above self" attitude, a primary tenet of their team's vision statement; and

WHEREAS, It is fitting that we acknowledge the hard work and successes of the University of Denver Pioneers men's ice hockey team and celebrate their 2022 NCAA championship win; and

WHEREAS, This win brings great honor and recognition to the University of Denver and the state of Colorado; now, therefore,

Be It Resolved by the Senate of the Seventy-third General Assembly of the State of Colorado, the House of Representatives concurring herein:
