# **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

#### **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.001** Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision that: (1) reflects for informational purposes the anticipated expenditure of \$1,500,000 cash funds from the Family and Medical Leave Insurance Fund by the Department of Labor and Employment in FY 2021-22; (2) appropriates \$231,920 reappropriated funds for FY 2021-22 to the Governor's Office of Information Technology from amounts expended by the Department of Labor and

Employment; and (3) appropriates \$105,878 reappropriated funds for FY 2021-22 to the Department of Law from amounts expended by the Department of Labor and Employment. The appropriation clause also states that the amounts are based on the assumptions that the Department of Labor will require an additional 6.0 FTE and the Department of Law will require an additional 0.6 FTE.

#### **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2021-22 budget package \$1,500,000 General Fund to be appropriated for implementation of this bill.
