

In the constitution of the state of Colorado, **add** section 33 to Article II as follows:

Section 33. RIGHT TO BE BORN.

LIVING CHILDREN SHALL BE PROTECTED FROM INTENTIONAL MUTILATION AND DEATH FROM THE MOMENT THEY ARE CONCEIVED.

Self-Executing. This provision of lawful protection shall be self-executing, meaning it does not need the governor's signature, and shall supersede any conflicting statutes, legislation, or judgments.

- a) **Applicability.** This act of protection applies beginning November 4, 2026, and is not retroactive, meaning that this act does not apply to actions prior to November 4, 2026.
- b) **Effective Date.** This act shall take effect November 4, 2026, if approved by the vote of the people.

In the constitution of the state of Colorado, **repeal** section 32 to Article II.
