Constitutional Amendment: A Child's Right to be Born, 2025-2026

In the constitution of the state of Colorado, add section 33 to Article II as follows:

Section 33. RIGHT TO BE BORN. LIVING CHILDREN SHALL BE PROTECTED FROM INTENTIONAL MUTILATION AND DEATH FROM THE MOMENT THEY ARE CONCEIVED.

Self-Executing. This provision of lawful protection shall be self-executing, meaning it does not need the governor's signature, and shall supersede any conflicting statutes, legislation, or judgments.

- a) Applicability. This act of protection applies beginning November 4, 2026, and is not retroactive, meaning that this act does not apply to actions prior to November 4, 2026.
- b) Effective Date. This act shall take effect November 4, 2026, if approved by the vote of the people.

In the constitution of the state of Colorado, repeal section 32 to Article II.
