- (g) The general fund appropriation for use by the division of youth services for medical services related to institutional programs is decreased by \$12,202.
- (2) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$158,295 is appropriated to the department of human services for use by the office of information technology services. This appropriation is from the general fund. To implement this act, the office may use this appropriation for Colorado trails.
- (3) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, the general assembly anticipates that the department of human services will receive \$81,546 in federal funds for use by the office of information technology services for Colorado trails to implement this act. The appropriation in subsection (2) of this section is based on the assumption that the department will receive this amount of federal funds, which is subject to the "(I)" notation as defined in the annual general appropriation act for the same fiscal year.
- (4) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, \$481,063 is appropriated to the department of human services for use by the division of child welfare. This appropriation is from the general fund and is based on an assumption that the division will require an additional 5.5 FTE. To implement this act, the division may use this appropriation for administration.
- (5) For the 2021-22 state fiscal year, the general assembly anticipates that the department of human services will receive \$25,167 in federal funds for use by the division of child welfare for administration to implement this act. The appropriation in subsection (4) of this section is based on the assumption that the department will receive this amount of federal funds, which is subject to the "(I)" notation as defined in the annual general appropriation act for the same fiscal year.".
