CONCERNING THE EMILY MAUREEN ELLEN KEYES ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATION AWARENESS FUND, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, CHANGING THE NAME OF THE FUND, EXTENDING THE REPEAL DATE OF THE FUND, REQUIRING AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE USE OF DONATED FUNDS, CLARIFYING THAT AN ORGAN AND TISSUE DONOR DESIGNATION IS EFFECTIVE UNLESS REVOKED BY THE DONOR, AND MAKING AN APPROPRIATION.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. If this bill passes third reading in the house of introduction, a bill summary that applies to the reengrossed version of this bill will be available at http://leg.colorado.gov/.)

Section 1 of the bill clarifies that designation as an organ and tissue donor (donor) by an applicant for a driver's license, instruction permit, or license renewal remains in effect until revoked by the applicant. Section 1 also removes the repeal date of the Emily Maureen Ellen Keyes organ and tissue donation awareness fund (fund). Section 2 of the bill continues the option that allows applicants for a driver's license, instruction permit, or license renewal to donate to the fund and, if not already a donor, to volunteer to become a donor. Section 3 of the bill requires the state auditor to conduct an audit of the fund every 10 years beginning on July 1, 2018, and submit the report to the legislative audit committee.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-107, amend

Application for license or instruction permit anatomical gifts - donations to Emily Keyes - John W. Buckner organ and tissue donation awareness fund - legislative declaration - rules **annual report - repeal.** (4)(b)(II) There is hereby created in the state treasury the Emily Maureen Ellen Keyes EMILY KEYES - JOHN W. BUCKNER organ and tissue donation awareness fund, which shall consist of all moneys credited thereto from all sources including but not limited to moneys collected from voluntary contributions for organ and tissue donation pursuant to subparagraph (V) of this paragraph (b) and section 42-2-118 (1)(a)(II). All moneys in the fund are hereby continuously appropriated to the department of the treasury and shall remain in the fund to be used for the purposes set forth in subparagraph (III) of this paragraph (b) and shall not revert to the general fund or any other fund. All interest derived from the deposit and investment of this fund shall be credited to the fund. At least quarterly, the state treasurer shall transfer all

inc., or its successor organization, as directed by sub-subparagraph (A) of

(III) At least quarterly, the state treasurer shall transfer all available moneys from the EMILY KEYES - JOHN W. BUCKNER organ and tissue donation awareness fund:

(A) To donor alliance, inc., or its successor organization, to provide funding for activities to promote organ and tissue donation through the creation and dissemination, by means of electronic media and otherwise, of educational information including public service announcements and information to increase awareness in the medical professions and related fields. Donor alliance, inc., or its successor organization, shall create, by amendment to its articles of incorporation or bylaws or otherwise, as appropriate, an advisory group to allocate moneys received pursuant to this sub-subparagraph (A). Such advisory body shall include a representative of any qualified transplant organization. Such organizations shall include those for organs, tissue, bone marrow, and blood AND LIVING DONATIONS. The advisory body created under this sub-subparagraph (A) shall report in writing in a form and manner determined by the department and at such intervals as required by the department on the use of moneys received under this sub-subparagraph (A). No moneys made available pursuant to this paragraph (b) shall be used to encourage fetal tissue donation.

(C) Before any payment to Donor Alliance, Inc., or its successor organization, from the EMILY KEYES - JOHN W. BUCKNER organ and tissue donation awareness fund may be made for any purpose, to the

department for the reasonable costs associated with the initial installation of the organ and tissue donor registry, the setup for electronic transfer of the donor information for the organ and tissue donor registry to the federally designated organ procurement organization, and computer programming, REPROGRAMMING, and form changes necessary as a result of the creation OR MODIFICATION of the organ and tissue donor registry.

(IV) Appropriations made by the general assembly pursuant to subparagraph (III) of this paragraph (b) shall not exceed moneys in the Emily Maureen Ellen Keyes EMILY KEYES - JOHN W. BUCKNER organ and tissue donation awareness fund that are available for appropriation.

(V) An applicant may make a donation of one dollar or more to the EMILY KEYES - JOHN W. BUCKNER organ and tissue donation awareness fund, created in subparagraph (II) of this paragraph (b), SUBSECTION (4)(b)(II) OF THIS SECTION, to promote the donation of organs and tissues under the provisions of the "Revised Uniform Anatomical Gift Act", part 1 of article 34 of title 12. C.R.S. The department shall collect such FINANCIAL donations and transmit them to the state treasurer, who shall credit the same THEM to the EMILY KEYES - JOHN W. BUCKNER organ and tissue donation awareness fund. The donation prescribed in this subparagraph (V) SUBSECTION (4)(b)(V) is voluntary and may be refused by the applicant. The department shall make available informational booklets or other informational sources on the importance of organ and tissue donations to applicants as designed and approved by the advisory body created under sub-subparagraph (A) of subparagraph (III) of this paragraph (b) SUBSECTION (4)(b)(III)(A) OF THIS SECTION. The department shall inquire of each applicant at the time the completed application is presented whether the applicant is interested in making a
