Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. The bill requires the department of military and veterans affairs to make grants to support the USS Colorado, a soon-to-be commissioned nuclear attack submarine, in order to:

Pay for expenses related to the commissioning of the USS Colorado: Promote awareness of the USS Colorado within the state; and Support the crew. For the 2017-18 fiscal year, \$200,000 is appropriated to the department of military and veterans affairs to make these grants. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add article 4.7 to title 28 as follows: ARTICLE 4.7 **USS** Colorado 28-4.7-101. Grants to support USS Colorado - legislative declaration - repeal. (1) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HEREBY FINDS AND **DECLARES THAT:** THE USS COLORADO IS A NUCLEAR ATTACK SUBMARINE
