The Senate State, Veterans, and Military Affairs Committee Report (05/03/16) amends the reengrossed bill to remove a one-time transfer of \$130,000 cash funds from the Colorado State Veterans Trust Fund to the Training Veterans to Train Their Own Service Dogs Pilot Program Fund. Without this transfer or any gifts, grants, or donations, money for the Program would need to be appropriated from the General Fund. Legislative Council Staff and JBC Staff agree that the following table summarizes the updated fiscal impact of the bill:

Current Appropriations Clause in Bill

The bill requires but does not contain an appropriation clause.

Description of Amendments in This Packet

J.001

Staff has prepared amendment **J.001** (attached) to add a provision appropriating a total of \$100,000 General Fund to the Department of Human Service for FY 2016-17. This provision also states that the appropriation is based on the assumption that the Department will require an additional 0.3 FTE.

Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2016-17 based on the March 2016 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package allocates \$3.0 million General Fund to be available to fund 2016 legislation that is not accounted for in the budget package. If the full \$3.0 million is not used to fund legislation, it will remain in the General Fund reserve.

Technical Issue

As noted on page 3 of the attached Fiscal Note, the bill limits the Department's expenditures to administer the program to 3.0 percent of the amount appropriated or transferred in a fiscal year. This provision allows the Department to spend up to \$3,000 of the \$100,000 made available for FY 2016-17 and FY 2017-18. However, the Department's actual administrative expenses are estimated at about \$24,900 for this two year period.
