DESIGN BID BUILD HIGHWAY PROJECT CONTRACT AWARDS **Bill Topic:**

This bill extends the authority of the Colorado Department of Transportation to award design-bid-build contracts in specified circumstances and requires potential projects to be prominently posted or linked on the home page of the department's website.

## **Summary of Legislation**

The bill allows the executive director of the Colorado Department of Transportation (CDOT) to delegate someone to award a design-bid-build contract in his or her place in a specified circumstance. It also eliminates the repeal of a law that authorizes the executive director to award a design-bid-build contract to a low bidder in specified circumstances. Finally, the bill requires CDOT to post or link to the list of projects it is seeking to contract for on its home page.

## **State Expenditures**

The bill is not expected to change how the department awards design-bid-build contracts. It will minimally increase workload to change where potential projects are posted on the website.

### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on May 29, 2018.
