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1 *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:*

2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-34-104, **repeal**  
3 (24)(a)(XII); and **add** (31)(a)(VIII) as follows:

4 **24-34-104. General assembly review of regulatory agencies**  
5 **and functions for repeal, continuation, or reestablishment - legislative**  
6 **declaration - repeal.** (24) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both,  
7 are scheduled for repeal on September 1, 2023:

8 (XII) ~~Human trafficking prevention training pursuant to section~~  
9 ~~24-33.5-523;~~

10 (31) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, are scheduled  
11 for repeal on September 1, 2030:

14 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 24-33.5-523, **amend**  
15 (7) as follows:

16 **24-33.5-523. Human trafficking prevention training - repeal.**  
17 (7) This section is repealed, effective September 1, ~~2023~~ 2030. Before its  
18 repeal, this section is scheduled for review in accordance with section  
19 24-34-104.

20 **SECTION 3. Act subject to petition - effective date.** This act  
21 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the  
22 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except  
23 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V  
24 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this  
25 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take

1 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in  
2 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the  
3 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
