

SENATE BILL 19-127

BY SENATOR(S) Moreno, Zenzinger, Rankin, Tate; also REPRESENTATIVE(S) Esgar, Hansen, Ransom, Pelton, Roberts.

CONCERNING FUNDING FOR CAPITAL CONSTRUCTION, AND MAKING SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. Capital construction appropriations for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018. In Session Laws of Colorado 2018, amend section 3 of chapter 424, (HB 18-1322), as follows:

Section 3. Capital Construction Appropriation.
