Sunset Process - Senate Health and Human Services

SENATE 3rd Reading Unamended February 14, 2017

SENATE Amended 2nd Reading February 13, 2017 **Committee.** The bill implements the recommendations of the sunset review and report on the certification of speech-language pathologists through the department of regulatory agencies by:

- ! Extending the automatic termination date of the "Speech-language Pathology Practice Act" to September 1, 2022, pursuant to the sunset law (sections 1 and 2 of the bill); and
- ! Removing references to the American Speech-Language-Hearing Association (sections 3 and 4 of the bill).

- 7 **declaration repeal.** (13) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both,
- 8 will repeal on September 1, 2017:
- 9 (II) The regulation of speech-language pathologists by the director
- of the division of professions and occupations in accordance with article
- 11 43.7 of title 12, C.R.S.;
- 12 (23) (a) The following agencies, functions, or both, will ARE
- 13 SCHEDULED FOR repeal on September 1, 2022:
- 14 (VIII) THE REGULATION OF SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGISTS BY
- 15 THE DIRECTOR OF THE DIVISION OF PROFESSIONS AND OCCUPATIONS IN

8	a person shall not practice speech-language pathology or represent or hold
9	himself or herself out as being able to practice speech-language pathology

11	in accordance with this article ARTICLE 43.7 and any rules adopted under
12	this article ARTICLE 43.7 OR A SPECIAL SERVICES LICENSE ISSUED BY THE
13	DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION PURSUANT TO SECTION 22-60.5-210.
14	SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.7-106, amend
15	(1)(c) as follows:
16	12-43.7-106. Certification - application - qualifications -

18	experiential requirements. Every applicant for a certification as a
19	speech-language pathologist must have:
20	(c) Passed the national examination adopted by the American
21	Speech-Language-Hearing Association or its successor association or any
22	other examination approved APPROPRIATE EXAMINATION AND CLINICAL
23	FELLOWSHIPS ADOPTED by the director.
24	SECTION 5. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.7-106.5,
25	amend (1)(b) and (5) as follows:
26	12-43.7-106.5. Provisional certification - qualifications -
27	application - expiration - practice. (1) Educational and experiential

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1	requirements. An applicant for a provisional certification as a
2	speech-language pathologist must:
3	(b) Pass either: The Appropriate examination and clinical
4	FELLOWSHIPS ADOPTED BY THE DIRECTOR.
5	(I) The national examination adopted by the American
6	Speech-Language-Hearing Association or its successor association; or
7	(II) Any other examination approved by the director.
8	(5) Practice. A provisional certificate holder may practice
9	speech-language pathology only under the general supervision of a
10	speech-language pathologist who holds a certificate of clinical
11	competence awarded by the American Speech-Language-Hearing
12	Association in accordance with the clinical fellowship requirements of the
13	American Speech-Language-Hearing Association AND HAS PASSED THE
14	APPROPRIATE EXAMINATION AND CLINICAL FELLOWSHIPS ADOPTED BY THE
15	DIRECTOR.
16	SECTION 6. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-43.7-108, amend
17	(1) introductory portion, (1)(d), and (1)(e); and add (1)(f) as follows:
18	12-43.7-108. Scope of article - exclusions. (1) This article
19	ARTICLE 43.7 does not prevent or restrict the practice, services, or
20	activities of:
21	(d) A person participating in good faith in a clinical fellowship if
22	the experience constitutes a part of the experience necessary to meet the
23	requirement of section 12-43.7-106 (1) and the person acts under
24	appropriate supervision; or
25	(e) Any legally qualified speech-language pathologist from another
26	state or country when providing services on behalf of a temporarily absent
27	speech-language pathologist certified in this state, so long as the

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1	uncertified speech-language pathologist is acting in accordance with rules
2	adopted by the director. The uncertified practice must not occur more than
3	once in any twelve-month period; OR
4	(f) A SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST WHO POSSESSES A SPECIAL
5	SERVICES LICENSE ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION PURSUANT
6	<u>TO SECTION 22-60.5-210.</u>
7	SECTION 7. Act subject to petition - effective date. This act
8	takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the
9	ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August
10	9, 2017, if adjournment sine die is on May 10, 2017); except that, if a
11	referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the
12	state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act
13	within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect
14	unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
15	November 2018 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the
16	official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.

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
