101 **CONCERNING THE RECOGNITION OF ALPHA DAY IN REMEMBRANCE OF**
102 **DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR.**

1 WHEREAS, On April 4, 1968, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was
2 killed by a sniper in Memphis, Tennessee; and

3 WHEREAS, Dr. King was an icon and a Baptist minister who led
4 the civil rights movement in the United States from the mid 1950s until
5 his death; and

6 WHEREAS, Dr. King's efforts, nonviolent tactics, and leadership
7 led to the Montgomery Bus Boycott and the founding of the Southern
8 Christian Leadership Conference, which helped end legal segregation of
9 African Americans in the south and other parts of the United States; and

2 Washington and the passing of the Voting Rights Act of 1965; and

3 WHEREAS, Since his death, the legacy, message, and
4 contributions of Dr. King have not only been recognized in America but
5 worldwide, so much so that a federal holiday honors him, as well as
6 monuments, streets, murals, and stamps that bear his name and image;
