101	CONCERNING CERTAIN LEGISLATIVE OVERSIGHT COMMITTEES, AND,
102	IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, MODIFYING THE MANNER IN
103	WHICH MEMBERS ARE APPOINTED TO THE COMMITTEES AND
104	SPECIFYING THAT THE CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR OF THE
105	EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ALSO
106	SERVE AS CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR OF THE LEGISLATIVE
107	COUNCIL.

Bill Summary

(Note: This summary applies to this bill as introduced and does not reflect any amendments that may be subsequently adopted. Executive Committee of the Legislative Council. The manner in which members are appointed to the legislative audit committee, the committee on legal services, and the legislative council is modified to:

- ! Provide for certain appointments to be made by the minority leaders of the house of representatives and the senate; and
- ! Eliminate the requirement that appointments to these committees be approved by a majority of the members of the house of representatives or the senate, as appropriate.

Currently, the legislative council annually elects a chair and vice-chair from its membership. The bill specifies that the chair and vice-chair of the executive committee now also serve as the chair and vice-chair of the legislative council.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-101, **amend** (1) as follows:

2-3-101. Legislative audit committee - membership - meetings - powers and duties. (1) There is hereby created a legislative audit committee, hereinafter referred to IN THIS PART 1 as the "committee". The membership of the committee shall consist CONSISTS of four senators, two from each major political party, to be appointed by the president AND THE MINORITY LEADER of the senate, with the approval of a majority of the members elected to the senate RESPECTIVELY, and four representatives, two from each major political party, to be appointed by the speaker AND THE MINORITY LEADER of the house of representatives, with the approval of a majority of the members elected to the house of representatives RESPECTIVELY. Appointments to the committee shall be made no later than sixty days after the convening of the first regular session of the general assembly held in each odd-numbered year. Membership on the committee shall terminate TERMINATES with the appointment of a

member's successor or upon the termination of a member's term of office in the general assembly, whichever occurs first, and any member may be appointed to succeed himself OR HERSELF on the committee. Vacancies in the committee's membership shall be ARE filled in the same manner as original appointments. except that the approval of the members elected to the general assembly is not necessary if any such appointment is made when the general assembly is not in session.

SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-301, **amend** (1) as follows:

2-3-301. Legislative council created - executive committee **created.** (1) There is hereby created a legislative council, referred to in this part 3 as the "council", which shall consist CONSISTS of an executive committee, six senators, to be WITH MAJORITY PARTY MEMBERS appointed by the president of the senate with the approval of a majority vote of the members elected to AND MINORITY PARTY MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF the senate, and six representatives, to be WITH MAJORITY PARTY MEMBERS appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives with the approval of a majority vote of the members elected to AND MINORITY PARTY MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE MINORITY LEADER OF the house of representatives. Except as otherwise provided in subsection (1.5) of this section, the executive committee shall be comprised CONSISTS of the president of the senate, the majority leader of the senate, the minority leader of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, the majority leader of the house of representatives, and the minority leader of the house of representatives, all of whom shall be ARE ex officio members of the council. The speaker of the house of representatives and the president of the senate shall alternately serve as

1	the chairman CHAIR and vice-chairman VICE-CHAIR of the executive
2	committee and shall serve for one-year terms. All ex officio members of
3	the council shall have and MAY exercise all the powers, privileges, and
4	duties of other members.
5	SECTION 3. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-302, amend (1)
6	as follows:
7	2-3-302. Organization - meetings. (1) The council shall select
8	a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership, who shall
9	serve for one-year terms CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR OF THE EXECUTIVE
10	COMMITTEE SHALL SERVE AS THE CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR OF THE COUNCIL;
11	and it THE COUNCIL shall prescribe its own rules of procedure, and may
12	appoint subcommittees from the membership of the general assembly and
13	other persons to assist in carrying out its functions.
14	SECTION 4. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-502, amend (3)
15	as follows:
16	2-3-502. Committee on legal services - membership - duties.
17	(3) The membership of the committee shall consist CONSISTS of ten
18	members of the general assembly. The ten legislative members of the
19	committee shall be ARE as follows: The respective chairmen CHAIRS of
20	the house and senate committees on judiciary or their respective
21	designees; four members from the house of representatives, two from
22	each major political party, one of whom shall be an attorney-at-law, if
23	there is an attorney-at-law in each party, appointed by the speaker AND
24	THE MINORITY LEADER of the house of representatives, with the approval
25	of a majority of the members elected to the house of representatives
26	RESPECTIVELY; and four members from the senate, two from each major
27	political party, one of whom shall be an attorney-at-law, if there is an

- attorney-at-law in each party, appointed by the president AND THE
 MINORITY LEADER of the senate, with the approval of a majority of the
 members elected to the senate RESPECTIVELY.

 SECTION 5. Safety clause. The general assembly hereby finds,
 determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
- 6 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
