General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2025-26 based on the March 2025 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2025-26 budget package the \$33,493,307 one-time General Fund savings from General Fund appropriations decreases and transfers of money to the General Fund in FY 2024-25 that result from the passage of this bill.
