SEX OFFENDER MANAGEMENT BOARD INTEREST CONFLICTS

Summary of Fiscal Impact:

**No fiscal impact.** This bill prohibits a member of the Sex Offender Management Board from receiving a direct financial benefit from the standards or guidelines

adopted by the board.

Appropriation Summary:

No appropriation is required.

Fiscal Note Status:

The revised fiscal note reflects the reengrossed bill.

# **Summary of Legislation**

This bill prohibits a member of the Sex Offender Management Board (SOMB) from receiving a direct financial benefit from the standards or guidelines adopted by the board, including a contract with the departments of Corrections, Human Services, or Public Safety, or the Judicial Department. The bill clarifies that being a governmental employee is not a direct financial benefit for purposes of the bill.

### Background

There are five current members of the SOMB that have contracts that would be prohibited under the bill. These contracts are not anticipated to be in place by the effective date of the bill.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

This bill does not affect the revenue, workload, or expenditures of any state agency and is, therefore, assessed as having no fiscal impact.

### **Effective Date**

The bill takes effect September 1, 2019, if no referendum petition is filed. It applies to members appointed or reappointed on, after, or before this date.
