- 7 "SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 25-1.5-121 as 8 follows:
 - **25-1.5-121. Pharmacy labels prescription accessibility grant program repeal.** (1) The prescription accessibility grant program is created in the department. The purpose of the grant program is to provide hardship grants to pharmacies for the purchase of equipment used to create accessible prescription labels.
 - (2) Grant recipients may use the money received through the grant program to purchase equipment used to create accessible prescription labels.
 - (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADMINISTER THE GRANT PROGRAM AND, SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE APPROPRIATIONS, SHALL AWARD GRANTS AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION. GRANTS MUST BE PAID OUT OF MONEY APPROPRIATED FOR THE GRANT PROGRAM AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (6) OF THIS SECTION.
 - (4) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL IMPLEMENT THE GRANT PROGRAM IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION. THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT MAY PROMULGATE THE RULES NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT PROGRAM.
 - (5) (a) TO RECEIVE A GRANT, A PHARMACY MUST SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE DEPARTMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULES PROMULGATED BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT.
 - (b) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REVIEW THE APPLICATIONS RECEIVED PURSUANT TO THIS SECTION.
 - (c) EACH GRANT RECIPIENT MAY BE AWARDED UP TO ONE THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS.
 - (6) SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE APPROPRIATIONS, ON OR BEFORE JULY 1, 2025, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL AWARD GRANTS AS PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE GRANT MONEY WITHIN FOURTEEN DAYS AFTER THE DEPARTMENT AWARDS THE GRANTS.
 - (7) On or before January 1, 2026, the department shall submit a summarized report to the house of representatives

HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE AND THE SENATE HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES COMMITTEE, OR THEIR SUCCESSOR COMMITTEES, ON THE GRANT PROGRAM. AT A MINIMUM, THE REPORT MUST INCLUDE THE NUMBER OF GRANTS AWARDED, THE AMOUNT OF EACH GRANT, AND THE GRANT RECIPIENTS.

- (8) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL APPROPRIATE EIGHTY THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE DEPARTMENT TO IMPLEMENT THE GRANT PROGRAM. THE DEPARTMENT MAY USE A PORTION OF THE MONEY APPROPRIATED FOR THE PROGRAM TO PAY THE DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS THAT THE DEPARTMENT INCURS TO ADMINISTER THE GRANT PROGRAM.
- 12 (9) This section is repealed, effective July 1, 2027.

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13 **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 14 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 15 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 16 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 17 18 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 19 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 20 November 2024 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 21 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.".

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
