"SECTION 11. Appropriation. (1) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$35,000,000 is appropriated to the department of public health and environment. This appropriation is from the economic recovery and relief cash fund created in section 24-75-228 (2)(a), C.R.S., and is of money the state received from the coronavirus state fiscal recovery fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation as follows: (a) \$2,000,000 for use by the office of emergency preparedness	

- resilience and retention cash fund;

 (b) \$10,000,000 for use by disease control and public health response for immunization operating expenses; and
 - (c) \$23,000,000 for use by the prevention services division for the primary care office.

- (2) For the 2022-23 state fiscal year, \$26,000,000 is appropriated to the department of higher education. This appropriation is from the economic recovery and relief cash fund created in section 24-75-228 (2)(a) C.R.S., and is of money the state recieved from the coronavirus state fiscal recovery fund. To implement this act, the department may use this appropriation for the state board for community colleges and occupational education state system community colleges."
