#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill amends the appropriations included in S.B. 21-196 (the annual legislative appropriation bill), increasing General Fund appropriations for use by the General Assembly for FY 2021-22 by \$617,348 and increasing the related FTE by 70.0.

## **Points to Consider**

#### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee (JBC) has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The JBC has included as part of its FY 2021-22 budget package a total of \$53,723,770 General Fund to be appropriated to the legislative department, including the \$617,348 appropriated in this bill.
