A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING EXTENDING THE EMILY KEYES - JOHN W. BUCKNER 102 ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATION AWARENESS FUND INDEFINITELY.

Bill Summary

The bill extends the Emily Keyes - John W. Buckner organ and tissue donation awareness fund indefinitely.

1	SECTION 1. Legislative declaration. (1) The general assembly
2	finds and declares that:
3	(a) The Emily Keyes - John W. Buckner organ and tissue donation
4	awareness fund ("fund") has helped to drive more than 15 million donor
5	registrations in Colorado since its inception in 2007;
6	(b) Since 2010, the fund has provided transplantation science
7	educational course training for 122,436 Colorado students in 4,847
8	classrooms;
9	(c) Over the last decade, the fund has printed and distributed over
10	10 million educational materials at 1,844 community events;
11	(d) 9,369 life-saving transplants were made possible by heroic
12	donors in Colorado's service area since the fund's inception in 2007, and
13	the number of transplants completed has been rising every year for the
14	past 12 years; and
15	(e) Donor Alliance, the federally designated nonprofit organ
16	procurement organization in Colorado, has successfully operated as a
17	fiduciary agent of the Emily Keyes - John W. Buckner organ and tissue
18	donation awareness fund since 2010, and Donor Alliance has provided
19	and will continue to provide all in-kind administrative support for the
20	fund. Donor Alliance supplements the initiatives of the fund with more
21	than the total amount the fund earns each year.
22	SECTION 2. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 42-2-107, repeal
23	(4)(b)(VIII) as follows:
24	42-2-107. Application for license or instruction permit -
25	anatomical gifts - donations to Emily Keyes - John W. Buckner organ
26	and tissue donation awareness fund - legislative declaration - rules -
27	annual report. (4) (b) (VIII) This subsection (4)(b) is repealed, effective

7	(1) (a) (II) (B) This subsection (1)(a)(II) is repealed, effective September
8	1, 2027.
9	SECTION 4. Safety clause. The general assembly finds,
10	determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate
11	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety or for appropriations for
12	the support and maintenance of the departments of the state and state
13	institutions.
