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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**  
101      **CONCERNING CONTINUATION OF THE CONSUMER INSURANCE COUNCIL.**

**Bill Summary**

**Sunset Process - House Health, Insurance, and Environment Committee.** The bill continues the consumer insurance council indefinitely and repeals the authority for the council to issue consumer's choice awards to health insurers.

1                   **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 10-1-133, **repeal**  
2                   (5.5) and (6) as follows:

3                   **10-1-133. Consumer insurance council - creation - advisory**  
4                   **body - appointment of members - meetings - repeal.** (5.5) The council  
5                   may issue an annual consumers' choice award to a health insurance carrier  
6                   that has achieved the lowest rates, highest benefits ratio, and lowest  
7                   complaint ratio for each line of insurance. In choosing the carrier to  
8                   receive the award, the council may also consider carrier-provided  
9                   consumer education, the extent of collaboration with the community to  
10                   meet the needs of the people the carrier serves, health care transparency,  
11                   health care innovation, the extent of consumer choice regarding health  
12                   care plans, and other relevant consumer-related choices as determined by  
13                   the council.

14                   (6) This section is repealed, effective ~~July 1, 2018~~ ~~SEPTEMBER 1,~~  
15                   2028; except that, prior to its repeal, the council shall be reviewed  
16                   pursuant to section 2-3-1203. C.R.S.

17                   **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, **repeal**  
18                   (6)(a)(I); and **add** (19) as follows:

19                   **2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative**  
20                   **declaration - definition - repeal.** (6) (a) The following statutory  
21                   authorizations for the designated advisory committees will repeal on July  
22                   1, 2018:

23                   (I) ~~The consumer insurance council created in section 10-1-133,~~  
24                   C.R.S.;

25                   (19) (a) THE FOLLOWING STATUTORY AUTHORIZATIONS FOR THE  
26                   DESIGNATED ADVISORY COMMITTEES WILL REPEAL ON ~~SEPTEMBER 1,~~  
27                   2028:

3 (b) THIS SUBSECTION (19) IS REPEALED, EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 1,  
4 2030.

5 **SECTION 3. Effective date.** This act takes effect July 1, 2018.

6                   **SECTION 4. Safety clause.** The general assembly hereby finds,  
7    determines, and declares that this act is necessary for the immediate  
8    preservation of the public peace, health, and safety.
