**BILL TOPIC:** AMATEUR WINEMAKER TASTINGS CONTESTS & JUDGINGS

#### **Summary of Legislation**

Under current law, amateur brewers and winemakers are exempt from liquor licensing requirements. Amateur brewers may participate in organized events, such as contests, tastings, or judgings, held at licensed premises, as long as portions do not exceed six ounces and are not sold, offered for sale, or made available for consumption by the general public. The bill allows amateur winemakers to also participate in organized events, provided the same portion and sale requirements are met.

#### **Assessment**

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact, as it does not impact the revenue or expenditures of any state or local government agency. Amateur winemakers are currently exempt from liquor licensing requirements, and the fiscal note assumes that any additional organized events held as a result of the bill will be held on premises that currently hold a valid liquor license.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on April 13, 2017, and takes effect August 9, 2017, assuming no referendum petition is filed. It applies to organized events held on or after the effective date.
