A BILL FOR AN ACT CONCERNING RESOURCES FOR FIRE INVESTIGATIONS TO ENHANCE PUBLIC SAFETY, AND, IN CONNECTION THEREWITH, PRIORITIZING FUNDING FOR WILDLAND FIRE INVESTIGATIONS.

Bill Summary

Wildfire Matters Review Committee. The bill directs the director of the division of fire prevention and control (division) within the department of public safety to report on the investigation of wildland fires in the state and creates the fire investigation fund to fund fire investigations.
