A BILL FOR AN ACT

101 CONCERNING THE DIVERSITY OF MEMBERS APPOINTED BY THE 102 GOVERNOR TO BOARDS AUTHORIZED BY THE GENERAL 103 ASSEMBLY.

Bill Summary

The bill requires the governor to appoint members of diverse groups to statewide boards, commissions, committees, and task forces authorized by the general assembly.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, add 24-20-115 as 3 follows: 4 24-20-115. Appointments by the governor - diversity -5 **definition.** (1) As used in this section, "board" means any 6 STATEWIDE BOARD, COMMISSION, COMMITTEE, OR TASK FORCE 7 AUTHORIZED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN WHICH ALL OF ITS MEMBERS 8 ARE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR. 9 (2) EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2022, WHEN MAKING APPOINTMENTS 10 TO OR FILLING VACANCIES OF ANY BOARD, THE GOVERNOR SHALL, TO THE 11 EXTENT POSSIBLE, APPOINT MEMBERS THAT, ALONG WITH MEETING THE 12 BOARD'S SPECIFIED MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS, REFLECT THE 13 GEOGRAPHIC AND DEMOGRAPHIC DIVERSITY OF THE ENTIRE STATE, 14 INCLUDING MEMBERS FROM BOTH RURAL AND URBAN PARTS OF THE STATE, 15 AND MEMBERS OF DIVERSE POLITICAL, RACIAL, AND CULTURAL GROUPS 16 AND OF DIVERSE SEXUAL ORIENTATIONS AND GENDERS. 17 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 18 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 19 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 20 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 21 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 22 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 23 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 24 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 25 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
