BILL TOPIC: REVISOR'S BILL

Summary of Legislation

This bill, *recommended by the Committee on Legal Services*, amends or repeals obsolete, unclear, or conflicting laws. The bill also clarifies statutory language, but does not change the intent or meaning of existing statute. The bill's appendix explains the reasons for each amendment.

Assessment

The bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The bill only makes technical changes to existing statute and does not impact the revenues or expenditures of any agency of state or local government.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect upon passage, with the following exceptions:

- Section 57 takes effect only if House Bill 16-1408 does not become law;
- Section 122 takes effect on the effective date of House Bill 16-1125; and
- Section 123 takes effect only if Senate Bill 16-051 becomes law, in which case Section 123 takes effect on July 1, 2016.
