SB19-019 be amended as follows, and as so amended, be referred to the Committee of the Whole with favorable recommendation and with a recommendation that it be placed on the consent calendar:

- 1 Amend printed bill, page 2, line 15, after "ENTITY," insert "LOCALIZED
- 2 EVIDENCE OF LOW FUEL MOISTURE CONTENT,".
- 3 Page 3, line 6, strike "section;" and substitute:
- 4 "section. However, if the county adopts a resolution specifying
- 5 THAT THE ORDINANCE REMAINS IN EFFECT FOR SUCH PERIOD, OR ANY
- 6 PORTION OF SUCH PERIOD, AND SUBSEQUENT TO THE ADOPTION OF THE
- 7 RESOLUTION, A CHANGE IN THE WEATHER OCCURS RESULTING IN
- 8 COMPETENT EVIDENCE THAT THE HIGH FIRE DANGER IS NOT PRESENT AND
- 9 NO LONGER WILL BE PRESENT DURING THE REMAINDER OF THE PERIOD, THE
- 10 COUNTY SHALL ENDEAVOR TO PROMPTLY CONSIDER WHETHER TO
- 11 EXERCISE ITS LEGISLATIVE DISCRETION TO RESCIND THE RESTRICTIONS IT
- 12 HAS ADOPTED ON THE SALE, USE, AND POSSESSION OF FIREWORKS.
- NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS SUBSECTION (1)(n.7),
- 14 THE ORDINANCE REMAINS IN EFFECT AND IS FULLY ENFORCEABLE UNTIL
- 15 THE RESTRICTIONS HAVE BEEN RESCINDED.".
