#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$580,000 cash funds from the Department of State Cash Fund to the Department of State for FY 2021-22. The Senate Finance Committee Report (05/19/21) includes an amendment that requires a General Fund appropriation for this bill.

## **Description of Amendments in This Packet**

**J.002** Staff has prepared amendment **J.002** (attached) to change the existing clause to appropriate \$580,000 from the General Fund rather than the Department of State Cash Fund.

#### **Points to Consider**

### General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2021-22 based on the March 2021 Legislative Council Staff revenue forecast. The budget package includes a set aside of \$48.0 million General Fund for bills that require General Fund appropriations for FY 2021-22. This bill requires a General Fund appropriation of \$580,000 for FY 2021-22, reducing the \$48.0 million set aside by the same amount.
