Sunset Process - House Public and Behavioral Health and

Human Servics Committee. The bill implements the recommendation of the department of regulatory agencies' sunset review and report concerning the strategic action planning group on aging by repealing the planning group.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, **repeal** part 34 of 3 article 32 of title 24. 4 **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 2-3-1203, repeal 5 (13)(a)(II) as follows: 6 2-3-1203. Sunset review of advisory committees - legislative 7 **declaration - definition - repeal.** (13) (a) The following statutory 8 authorizations for the designated advisory committees are scheduled for 9 repeal on September 1, 2022: 10 (II) The strategic action planning group on aging created in 11 section 24-32-3404, C.R.S.; 12 **SECTION 3.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 13 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 14 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly; except 15 that, if a referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V 16 of the state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this 17 act within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take 18 effect unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in 19 November 2022 and, in such case, will take effect on the date of the 20 official declaration of the vote thereon by the governor.
