Summary of Legislation

Under current law, an entity may file a statement of correction with the Secretary of State's Office (SOS) to revoke a previously filed document under certain conditions. This bill allows statements of correction to also be filed for a document that was delivered and filed in error.

State Expenditures

This bill increases SOS workload by a minimal amount to process any statement of correction received for a document that was filed in error. This workload increase can be accomplished within existing appropriations.

Effective Date

The bill takes effect August 10, 2016, if the General Assembly adjourns on May 11, 2016, as scheduled, and no referendum petition is filed and applies to conduct occurring on or after the effective date.
