Summary of Legislation

The bill replaces existing gendered language with gender-neutral language in Title 35 (Agriculture) of the Colorado Revised Statutes. It also updates archaic language in the title.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

Making nonsubstantive changes to Title 35 does not affect the revenue or expenditures for any state or local government. The Revisor of Statutes can make the updates within the normal course of business. As such, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on March 26, 2025, and takes effect on August 6, 2025, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
