#### **Summary of Legislation**

**Recommended by the Joint Budget Committee**, this bill reduces the FY 2015-16 statutory General Fund reserve from 6.5 percent to 5.6 percent.

#### **Background**

Under current law, the statutory reserve is 6.5 percent of General Fund expenditures. With the budget passed for FY 2015-16 and the revenue forecast for current fiscal year collections, the General Fund reserve will be less than the amount required to meet the 6.5 percent requirement.

#### **State Expenditures**

Reducing the required reserve from 6.5 percent to 5.6 percent allows the state to spend an additional \$83.7 million in FY 2015-16 that has already been appropriated. This bill does not impact the General Fund reserve in future fiscal years.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on May 4, 2016.
