BOARD MEETING DATES SW WATER CONSERVATION DIST

Summary of **Fiscal Impact:**  No fiscal impact. This bill requires that the board of the Southwestern Water Conservation District meet once every three months, instead of meeting on statutorily specified days and months. The bill does not change revenue, expenditures, or

workload for the conservation district.

**Appropriation** Summary:

No appropriation is required.

**Fiscal Note** Status:

This fiscal note reflects the introduced bill.

## **Summary of Legislation**

Under current law, the board of the Southwestern Water Conservation District is required to meet on the fourth Tuesday of January, April, July, and October. This bill requires that the board meet once every three months, and removes the specific date requirements.

## **Assessment of No Fiscal Impact**

The total number of board meetings of the conservation district is unchanged by this bill. The board must still meet at least four times annually; however, the specified day of these meetings is no longer dictated in law. The bill does not impact the revenue, expenditures, or workload of the district, or of any state agency or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was signed into law by the Governor and took effect on April 12, 2018.
