Points to Consider

General Fund Impact

The Joint Budget Committee has proposed a budget package for FY 2018-19 based on the March 2018 Office of State Planning and Budgeting revenue forecast. The budget package leaves approximately \$40.8 million General Fund unallocated. This bill is anticipated to reduce General Fund revenues by up to \$108,750 in FY 2018-19, reducing the excess General Fund reserve by the same amount. The bill is anticipated to reduce General Fund revenues by up to \$223,500 in FY 2019-20 and subsequent years.
