Summary of Legislation

The bill amends or repeals obsolete, unclear, or conflicting laws. The bill also clarifies statutory language, but does not change the intent or meaning of these sections of law. The appendix of the bill explains the reasons for each change.

Assessment of No Fiscal Impact

The bill makes technical changes to laws that do not impact the revenues, expenditures, or workload of any state agency or local government. For this reason, the bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact.

Effective Date

The bill was signed into law by the Governor on June 4, 2026, and takes effect August 6, 2025, assuming no referendum petition is filed.
