Bill Summary

For the purposes of the schedules of controlled substances, the bill exempts from the definition of "anabolic steroid" any substance that is otherwise defined as an anabolic steroid if it is administered through injection into cattle or other nonhuman species and has been approved by the secretary of health and human services for such administration.

1 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Colorado: 2 **SECTION 1.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 18-18-102, amend 3 (3)(b) as follows: 4 **18-18-102. Definitions.** As used in this article: 5 (3) (b) (I) Except as provided in subparagraph (II) of this 6 paragraph (b), such term SUBSECTION (3)(b)(II) OF THIS SECTION, 7 "ANABOLIC STEROID" does not include an anabolic steroid which THAT is 8 expressly intended for administration through implants to OR INJECTION 9 INTO cattle or other nonhuman species and which THAT has been 10 approved by the secretary of health and human services for such 11 administration. 12 (II) If any person prescribes, dispenses, or distributes a steroid 13 described in subparagraph (I) of this paragraph (b) SUBSECTION (3)(b)(I) 14 OF THIS SECTION for human use, such person shall be IS considered to 15 have prescribed, dispensed, or distributed an anabolic steroid within the 16 meaning of paragraph (a) of this subsection (3) SUBSECTION (3)(a) OF 17 THIS SECTION. 18 **SECTION 2.** Act subject to petition - effective date. This act 19 takes effect at 12:01 a.m. on the day following the expiration of the 20 ninety-day period after final adjournment of the general assembly (August 21 9, 2017, if adjournment sine die is on May 10, 2017); except that, if a 22 referendum petition is filed pursuant to section 1 (3) of article V of the 23 state constitution against this act or an item, section, or part of this act 24 within such period, then the act, item, section, or part will not take effect 25 unless approved by the people at the general election to be held in
