#### **Current Appropriations Clause in Bill**

The bill includes an appropriation clause that appropriates \$3,000,000 cash funds to the Department of Higher Education for FY 2022-23. The amount reflects the assumption that the Department will require an additional 1.0 FTE in FY 2022-23, which will continue in FY 2023-24. The funds are from the Workers, Employers and Workforce Centers Cash Fund, from amounts originating as General Fund. Based on statutory provisions in the bill, funds not expended in FY 2022-23 roll forward to FY 2023-24 without further appropriation.

#### **Points to Consider**

Technical/Process Issue

If this proposal had been submitted as a budget request, it would have been subject to review by the Joint Technology Committee (JTC) pursuant to the provisions of Section 2-3-1704, C.R.S., and Joint Rule 45.
